SCREENING LICENSE AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is made to grant the applicant a single license for the limited, non-broadcast, public exhibition of the film *SOMEBODY'S DAUGHTER* (the "FILM") only in accordance with all information supplied by the screener on this form.

The license fee for screening the FILM is waived and the screener agrees to pay shipping & handling and any applicable tax. (To upgrade this license to cover a larger audience or screen it more than once, send your request to sara@global-tribes.com.)

In consideration of payment of the shipping & handling provided for above, the LICENSOR will provide the LICENSEE with one (1) copy of the FILM to be used for the screening, electronic publicity materials (if any) and this license to screen the film once in front of the estimated audience as indicated.

The LICENSOR agrees that the LICENSEE may charge admission to the screening but that all profits received from ticket sales or related sales to this screening, will go to organizations supporting MMIW or issues of violence against native women, and that the LICENSEE will provide documentation for LICENSOR'S records.

NOTE: This may mean that your organization keeps profits from your event and uses the money to support your own efforts for MMIW or issues of violence against native women. You may also donate all profits to another reliable MMIW organization or donate through our website to enable screenings in tribal, underserved or rural areas.

The LICENSOR hereby grants to the LICENSEE, without warranty, a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to screen the FILM on the SCREENING DATE only, subject to the terms and conditions specified herein, as follows:

- 1) The LICENSEE hereby expressly agrees that the FILM shall be used only for the permitted purposes as set forth in this AGREEMENT and for no other purpose.
- 2) The LICENSEE agrees that the FILM may be exhibited in more than one screening on the SCREENING DATE, but that permission for additional exhibition dates must be made to the LICENSOR by email so that return of the film can be arranged.
- 3) The LICENSEE agrees that **it shall not permit the FILM to be duplicated, sold, loaned, transferred, televised or made available online or to any other party** not contained herein at any time or in any manner other than as provided for in this AGREEMENT.

The DVD must be returned promptly (next day) after the screening using the pre-paid and pre-filled materials supplied. If anything interrupts this process, you agree to notify us by email.

With respect to the License granted hereunder, it is expressly understood and acknowledged by the LICENSEE that any rights, title, or interest that the LICENSOR maintains with respect to the FILM are expressly reserved by the LICENSOR. This AGREEMENT constitutes the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and any amendments, changes, or modifications shall have legal effect and be binding only if made in writing and signed by both parties.
